FULL-DAY PROGRAM: 9am to 4pm

Building friendships to last a lifetime! A variety of age-appropriate activities will keep campers busy all day. Daily activities include volleyball, tennis, kickball, arts & crafts, music, free swim, pool games, Color Wars, field trips, annual Talent Show, and more! And, if you're new to Camp, it won't take you long to learn how to play Ga-Ga in our Ga-Ga Pit! Group swim instruction is provided in the morning (at no additional charge) by experienced Red Cross-certified instructors. Campers are asked to bring a dairy lunch and beverage. Daily snacks will be provided.

Camp Olim "Explorers"

AGES: Kindergarten & 1st Grade

HALF-DAY OPTION: 9am to 12:30pm

FULL-DAY OPTION: 9am to 4pm

Sports, storytelling, arts & crafts, music and games with emphasis on fun and cooperation. Water safety and introduction to the swimming pool in the 2-foot end. Campers (includes half-day campers) are asked to bring their own dairy lunch and beverage. Daily snack will be provided.

CIT "Counselors In Training"

GRADES: 7th to 9th

This program is for teens going into grades 7 through 9. It will provide a chance for this age group to acquire the skills to eventually move into a counselor position while giving them a safe and fun place to spend their summer.

This is a full-day program at half-day prices. CITs will be assigned to groups during the morning and will have the afternoon to spend as a group together doing sports activities, swimming and trips. This program is a weekly camp, but we encourage our CIT's to come all summer.

LANCASTER JCC SUMMER CAMP 2012 TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Camp registration begins March 1, 2012. Registration may be done in person, mailed in or completed online.
- Acceptable forms of payment are cash, check and all major credit cards. Payment can be made in person, via mail or via phone (credit cards only).
- All camp registration forms must be completely filled out and deposits are due at time of registration. If registering online, please send in or call with your deposit within three days of submitting your online form.
- All emergency contact information and camper pickup information must be filled out prior to camp starting on June 25, 2012. Please send any changes in writing to the front desk either in person, through the mail or via email at ljcc@lancasterjcc.org. Unless we have a change in writing, we will not allow your camper to be picked up by anyone other than the parent/guardian.
- Please inform the Summer Camp Director of any special needs or limitations your camper may have.
- There is a one-time family registration processing fee of \$40 per family to be paid at the time of registration.
- A \$50 per week per camper nonrefundable deposit is due for each camper to hold your camper's spot. This deposit will be deducted from your final camp balance due.
- All camp fees are due by June 18, 2012. Your camper will not be allowed to attend camp sessions unless the camp fees have been paid. All other payment arrangements must be made in writing and signed by the Executive Director of the Lancaster JCC.
- Sibling Discounts: Sibling discounts are available to those siblings attending the same week(s) of camp. This discount is \$15 per each additional sibling per week. It does not apply to the first camper who must pay regular camp fee prices.
- Any family that signs up for all eight weeks of camp will receive a \$200 per family discount on registration. Sibling discount will still apply (see above).
- The one-time registration fee of \$40 and all weekly deposit fees (\$50 per week per camper) are nonrefundable. Any refunds will be given on a case-by-case basis and are subject to approval by the Summer Camp Director and the Executive Director of the LJCC. Any refunds will be issued within thirty days of written withdrawal.
- We cannot offer any make-up days for missed camp due to the short time frame of our summer camp.
- We will be having camp on Wednesday, July 4, 2012. If you have signed up for this week and choose to not send your camper on this day, you will not be issued any discounts or refunds.
- Schedule Changes: All changes to camp schedule must be made in writing and submitted to the main LJCC office within three days prior to that change. All camp fees associated with schedule changes must be paid at time of submission of changes.
- All campers are asked to bring a packed dairy or vegetarian lunch each day for camp. Examples of foods allowed are PB&J, bagels, cream cheese, cheese, tuna salad, yogurt, fruit, etc. Foods not allowed are any meat, pork or shellfish products. - Please inform the Summer Camp Director of any special dietary needs and we will do our best to ensure that we follow those needs.
- The Lancaster JCC reserves the right to cancel a field trip, camp day or camp week in case of emergency. Every attempt will be made to contact camp registrants to inform them of the cancellation.
- Specialty camps may be going on simultaneously throughout the camp week. Some of these camps are handled directly through the Lancaster JCC and some are not. For those camps handled by outside vendors, please contact them directly.
- Camp is on rain or shine. In the event of inclement weather, Operation Raindrop goes into effect and all campers will enjoy rainy-day activities in our indoor facilities.
- Financial assistance is available to those who qualify. Financial aid forms can be obtained at the main LJCC office. Please fill one out and submit it to the Executive Director along with registration information and appropriate financial documents.
- All information is kept confidential.
